EQUIPMENT MAKES A DIFFERENCE

Collar *noun*

- ▶ a band, strip, or chain worn around the neck
- ▶ a device worn around a dog's neck, usually made of leather or woven material, with a buckle or fastener
- ▶ a part of the harness fitted over the shoulders and taking strain when a load is drawn
- ▶ an indication of control : a token of subservience
 - ▶ use determines humaneness and effectiveness

basic necessity, training tool

Harness *noun*

- ▶ the equipment of a animal
- ▶ device usually fits around animal's body, especially the ribs and chest
- ▶ equipment for safety, control, or purposeful work

Basic necessity? Training tool? Working gear?

Lead *noun*

- ▶ legal definition: something serving as a tip, indication, or clue
- ▶ often used interchangeably with “leash”
 - ▶ leash that facilitates communication and/or safety
 - ▶ a more sophisticated, specific tool

Lead *transitive verb*

- ▶ to guide on a way especially by going in advance
- ▶ to direct on a course or in a direction, activity, or performance of
- ▶ to tend toward, or have a result

Leash *noun*

- ▶ a line for leading or restraining an animal
- ▶ generally a rope, strap of leather or other material that connects a dog to a handler

basic necessity, training tool

Tool *noun*

- ▶ a handheld device that aids in accomplishing a task
- ▶ something (such as an instrument or apparatus) used in performing an operation or necessary in the practice of a vocation or profession
- ▶ a means to an end
