BLD's world-famous service dog harness is designed to provide balance and stability support for people with physical, mobility-related disabilities. It offers great communication and contact with their service dog. We have designed these harnesses with the dog's physical structure and movement in mind, then added features to make it user-friendly and truly accessible. This is the most stable, ergonomic and functional service dog harness available! BLD's innovative harness design has benefited thousands of people around the world since 2009.

Our harnesses are specifically designed to allow a specially trained service dog to assist with balance and stabilization while standing or walking, maintaining a regular gait, assist with getting up from a seated position or from the floor, orientation or proprioception, and other assistance that requires tactile feedback and communication with an assistance dog. People with symptoms such as vertigo, gait impairment, disequilibrium, chronic pain, etc. often train their dog to assist with tasks such as counterbalance, momentum pulling, leading or guiding, and occasional bracing.



Crafting each harness to order is how we provide the right fit for the dog while meeting each user's individual needs. We offer a variety of harness sizes, handle styles, accessibility features, and accessories you can combine to create the right harness for both you and your service dog. This information booklet will describe all of the options available.










There are two versions of this harness. The difference is the primary handle.



Balance Assistance Harness (BAH)
Features a sturdy, low-impact
leather handle



Mobility Support Harness (MSH)
Has a rigid metal support handle
that can offer light bracing

You will select the harness style and handles based on how you would like your dog to assist with your mobility. Each of the various handle styles is created to perform specific mobility tasks. There are several handle options to choose from (harnesses can have multiple handles) each is explained in detail in this booklet.

Please note: Your harness will be made to accommodate the primary handle style you choose. The handle mounting hardware on the saddle cannot be changed after the harness is made. This means the primary BAH and MSH handles are not interchangeable.

For example, a metal handle cannot be put on a Balance Assistance Harness. Likewise, the metal handle supports cannot be removed from a Mobility Support Harness.

Tall MSH metal handles (9-11") require a saddle with tall/heavy support bars; any MSH harness can accommodate a shorter handle.

Important Notes: please read this before ordering

At Bold Lead Designs, we take the health and safety of your dog seriously. We have created these guidelines based on over 15 years of experience with this specialized equipment.

Dogs must be physically mature and of appropriate size, fitness and soundness for the work you would like them to perform. Mobility, stability, and balance assistance work are physically demanding. A service dog should always be in prime physical condition to remain healthy.

Age, Size and Fitness:

Dogs should be at least 18 months of age before beginning harness work. The dog's growth plates must be closed before starting to train a dog for harness work. This happens for most large breed dogs at 18-24 months of age and giant breeds need even longer to mature. Please allow your dog time to grow and mature as rushing into harness work may cause injury and shorten your dog's working life. Additionally, if the harness is ordered too soon it will cost you significantly more money if your dog outgrows the harness.

Dogs MUST be in our recommended weight/measurement range set forth in the sizing guide for the harness to fit and function properly.

We want to see properly exercised, fit, lean, muscular dogs! Overweight dogs should never be expected to perform load bearing tasks; additionally, obesity contributes to serious health risks and can significantly shorten a dog's lifespan. Consider implementing an exercise and fitness routine when the dog is "off duty" to keep him/her in good shape.

Consult the Pros:

Consulting a qualified veterinarian (orthopedic specialist or canine sports medicine physical therapist) is highly recommended for all service/assistance dogs that perform physical tasks. Radiographs (x-rays) or other tests may be recommended by the vet and are required by most service dog training organizations to determine if the dog is suitable for the demands of service dog work.

Harness users should consult a physician and physical therapist to determine what medical equipment is appropriate for their mobility needs. **BLD harnesses are <u>not</u> intended to serve as, or to <u>replace</u>, a durable medical device such as a cane, walker, or crutch. Please understand that one should never lean on a dog to stay upright. Rigid metal handles must not be pushed or pulled on while the dog is in motion. Such use is not how the harness is intended to be used and could put the dog at risk for injury.**

Fit and performance of the equipment can only be assured if the dog meets the minimum recommended standards, the user and trainer have reasonable expectations, and when the equipment is used responsibly for the purpose it was designed.

Our equipment is designed to allow an appropriately selected and trained service dog to reasonably assist a person with a balance, mobility impairment, or other disability that requires specialty service dog gear. BLD cannot assess a dog's suitability or appropriateness. Users assume all responsibility for the safety, health, and care of the animal and human alike.

In your dog's best interest, please understand that BLD may decline an order if we believe a harness could be harmful to the dog because of age, size, or unreasonable expectations.

Harness Design

We have developed our harnesses with the dog's physiology and movement in mind, then added features to make them user-friendly and accessible.

Guided by canine sports medicine experts, canine physical therapists, and a veterinary orthopedic surgeon, BLD's unique harness design allows the dog to work with minimal impact from the equipment.

Each component of the harness has been specifically designed to perform mobility related tasks and close-contact communication.

Similar to a horse saddle, this harness sits just behind the dog's withers (or shoulders), around the dog's center of gravity. From the handle mounting hardware to the position of the straps the harness is engineered to properly support the handles and distribute pressure around the core of the dog's body, with minimal impact on the dog's movement.

We've incorporated many features so you can get the most out of your custom harness. We believe the right gear that meets your needs and makes life a little easier is an investment in your independence and health as well as your service dog's well-being.

BLD Harnesses Features

- A variety of handle options are available to meet your needs.
 - Handles are made to your desired height, are well-balanced and properly supported for maximum stability assistance.
- Choose the harness style based on the primary handle you need.
 - Balance Assistance Harness with flexible leather handle, see pages 7-11.
 - Mobility Support Harness with rigid metal handle, see pages 12-17.
 - Additional handles are available on all harnesses to add more functionality, such as pulling and leading.
- We use only premium quality full grain leather and durable hardware, combined with fine workmanship, to deliver a quality, utilitarian product for a lifetime of reliable performance.
- · Layers of specialized padding
 - o The main saddle has layers of specialized padding hidden inside.
 - Padding provides comfort and protects the dog's spine.
 - Harness is flexible and comfortable with no hard edges.
- Lined with natural shearling wool
 - All points where the harness makes contact with the dog are padded with genuine shearling wool (AKA natural sheepskin) to prevent pinching and rubbing.
 - Shearling wool is an incredibly durable natural material with antimicrobial properties; it provides both comfort and structural support for the function of the harness.









- Wool resists odors, provides optimal cushion and air flow, and will remain comfortable for your dog in any climate!
- Natural shearling wool does NOT build up heat, or cause irritation the way synthetic materials can. In fact our harness is less hot than a fabric vest even on the hottest days in tropical and desert climates. This may sound counterintuitive, but wool insulates in both directions.
- A wool-free option is available for true allergies—inquire for details if required.

Adjustable Straps


- o Each harness is made to fit your dog's measurements.
- All straps have several inches of adjustment to fine-tune the fit to your dog's individual anatomy; this allows for change in coat length and normal weight fluctuation (remember to keep your dog fit and lean).

• Interchangeable Parts

- The Balance Assistance and Mobility Support harnesses have been designed with interchangeable parts.
- The girth strap, belly strap and breastplate can be replaced to easily re-fit the harness to another dog that would wear the same size saddle.
- Handles are removable and can be interchanged with a similar handle style.
- Surprisingly Lightweight despite its sturdy nature!
 - A complete standard size harness weighs less than two and a half pounds (one kilogram) and around 3 pounds (1.3 KG) for the giant size .
- Quick-Release latches make it easy to put on and take off the dog, plus the harness remains adjusted when removed
 - o For on and off, simply click two easy-to-use latches.
 - Metal side-release buckles are standard, They are spring loaded and easy to operate for most clients.
 - Magnetic latch option is available for those with low dexterity or hand strength.




The magnetic latch is amazing! Originally designed for motorcycle helmets, it's reliable and secure under load. These latches self-align; the magnet pulls the latch together and automatically fastens closed. Pulling on the straps will not open the latch, however it's very easy to undo the latch with a light pull on the release tab.

Quick Release Latches

- D-rings for attaching accessories, such as a cape, pouch, ID badges, or a pulling strap are included.
 - Five D-rings come standard: three on the top of the saddle, and two lower D-rings (one on each side, at the base of the handle).
- Easy to clean and maintain,, Details available on our website and in the Owner's Manual.
 - Simply apply leather conditioner regularly to clean and condition the leather and the harness will remain supple and weather resistant for years to come.

- Clean the wool lining with a brush and vacuum away any debris.

Measuring instructions are included here in this packet, as well as by video on our website. We require measurements of both the dog and the person who will use the harness. Now, let's take an in-depth look at the handles available. We'll start with the Balance Assistance Harness.

Balance Assistance Harness (BAH)

with leather handle

Who is it for? The BAH is a good choice for many people with conditions such as vertigo, balance or gait impairment, disequilibrium, neurological conditions, brain injuries, Parkinson's, MS, cardiopulmonary disorders, etc. where light to moderate contact with a flexible handle can assist with stability.

We at BLD think this harness is the best option for most of our clients with mobility needs! This harness offers counterbalance, pulling, and excellent communication with the dog. The BAH can provide stabilization while standing or walking, momentum pull to help maintain a regular gait, leading/guiding feedback, and/or getting up from a seated position.

- The BAH has the most handle options
 - All will be made to your desired height/length
 - You may choose one or a combination of Assistance Handle styles for specific tasks you'd like your dog to perform
 - The second handle can be longer or shorter than the primary handle to allow the dog to assist with additional tasks
- All BAH handles are crafted with sturdy, double-layered leather and are custom-made to your desired height or length in your choice of firmness.
 - Flexible handles are soft and will become more supple over time
 - Semi-rigid handles are reinforced to allow them to hold their shape and offer increased feedback

NOTES: This harness does NOT offer bracing. Leather assistance handles are lower impact and generally safer for the dog than a rigid metal handle. This harness will not fit dogs smaller than the minimum weight and measurement size and cannot be adjusted or made smaller than stated.

Harness Sizes:

Standard BAH

For most dogs 45-95 pounds, with a girth size of 26-34 inches (best choice for most retrievers and doodles).

Extra Large BAH

For most dogs 90-150 pounds, with a girth size of 33-40 inches (also recommended for deep-chested breeds such as GSD's and Dobermans weighing 85 pounds or more, or <u>any dog over 100</u> pounds such as Rottweilers, smaller Great Danes, Newfoundlands, Bernese, etc.).

Giant BAH

For dogs 150-200 pounds, with a girth over 40 inches (best choice for larger Great Danes, St. Bernards, Mastiffs, etc.). Only available in black.

Harness Leather Color Options:

Black

Our standard offering is Black Latigo leather. The leather is solid black all the way through and therefore it does not fade. It hides the appearance of scuffs and wears beautifully over time.

London Tan

Gorgeous bridle leather. Tan shades may vary slightly; each part of harness may be a different shade but always coordinate beautifully. May darken and show some scuffs with use over time. (Not available in giant size.)

Girth and Belly Strap Latch Options:

Quick-Release Buckles

Default standard option: All metal buckles are easy to operate. Spring-loaded side release style requires only light pressure to open.

One-Hand latch operation

D-rings placed near the quick release make it easier to grasp the straps and fasten with one hand.

Magnetic Latches

Ideal for those with very limited strength or dexterity! This amazing latch, designed for motorcycle helmets, is reliable and secure under load. These latches self-align and hook closed when fastening the straps; incredibly easy to release by pulling the red tabs. Includes D-ring on the strap for one-handed use.

BAH Primary Leather Assistance Handles:

Handles over 4 ½" (11 cm) tall will be made with a horizontal brace strap to stabilize the handle loop. Handles 18" (45cm) or longer require a custom sleeve to support the handle properly (not shown, additional cost).

Balance Handle (vertical)

Flexible Balance Handle

The vertical **Balance Handle** is the standard option for the BAH. This leather handle is positioned vertically on the harness and is stabilized to provide excellent feedback and communication with your dog. It mounts low on the harness saddle with quick-release latches, and is kept upright with heavy-duty Orings.

This one is **best for counterbalance while standing and light contact while walking.** It is recommended for people that have non-fluid movement yet need a sturdy handle.

The flexible handle will soften and slump over time.

Semi-Rigid Balance Handle

Highly recommended! Most popular as a primary handle.

Same look and features as the above option. Reinforced with a rawhide core for a firmer feel and increased feedback. This handle will hold its form and **stand upright,** making it accessible for grasping without bending over. Very sturdy yet does not transfer excess motion or torque to the dog like a metal handle does. Good for counterbalance and stability, especially for people that have non-fluid movement yet need a sturdy option.

Support Pull Handle (angles back)

Flexible Leather Support Pull Handle

Designed for heavier momentum and pulling needs, this handle provides <u>optimal</u> <u>pulling pressure distribution</u>.

This handle is best for those who need moderate gait stabilization, counterbalance and/or a sturdy momentum pull while walking. It's ideal for those who want their dog to pull into the harness for assistance to stand from a seated position. Handle attaches low on the harness in the most ergonomic location for the dog to pull with minimal effort; pressure is directed under the dog so the his/her mass does the work. "Mouse ear" loops keep the handle in position at a slight angle back. This handle drops a bit when you let go of it, has a looser feel than the vertical balance handle, but also offers more support.

Semi-Rigid Leather Support Pull

Highly recommended! Most popular as a second handle. Offers the most support while dog is in motion. Same looks and features as the above option. Reinforced with a rawhide core for a firmer feel and increased feedback. The Semi-Rigid Support Pull Handle is our most popular and is recommended for most of our clients. This one is fantastic as either a primary or secondary handle. It pairs well with the standard vertical Balance Handle.

BAH Additional Leather Handle options:

Clip-on Balance Handle (loose):

Clip-on Balance Handle is a minimal, low profile option. It clips onto heavy-duty O-rings toward the top of the harness saddle. Handle lays down when you let go of it. Ideal for a short grab-handle (3-4") for counterbalance, getting up from a seated position. This handle has a looser feel than the above options. We think it's best as an additional handle paired with the Support Pull handle. Semi-rigid is available, but will not improve it's performance. (Not built into the harness, can be added anytime.)



Clip-on Balance Handle (loose)

Basic Pull Strap:

This simple leather strap is adjustable and forms a 3-6" adjustable handle when clipped onto the standard D-rings. It makes a good secondary handle for general use. Good for getting up from a seated position, or occasional wheelchair pulling. For wheelchair pulling, some clients use this handle offset, clipped to the top and side of the harness. (Not built into the harness, can be added anytime.)



Basic Pull Strap

Leather Guide Handle:

Available in Flexible or Semi-Rigid Option

Leather **Guide Handles** are for light-duty leading/guiding. This handle offers good directional communication. It attaches to the front edge of the harness saddle via quick-release buckles and angles back. Velcro stabilizers help keep the handle in position. In general, most clients find the **support pull** handle to be more useful.

Available as a flexible handle, or semi-rigid which is reinforced for a sturdier feel. This is our least popular handle option.

Notes: it will not perform like a traditional hard-handled guide harness. Not compatible with Support Pull or Mobility Support handles.

Mobility Support Harness (MSH)

with rigid metal support handle

Starting at \$585. See price list on p. 17

Who is it for? The MSH can be a good option for people with balance impairment, disequilibrium, neurological conditions, or other conditions where light to moderate contact with a rigid vertical handle can assist with orientation and/or balance support. This harness can provide light bracing while the dog and the person are both standing.

An <u>additional leather handle</u> can be added to allow the MSH to assist with momentum, gait stabilization, pulling, leading, and counterbalance support while in motion.

- Rigid metal Support Handle made from lightweight, high-grade aluminum.
- Provides vertical stability support and can be used for occasional light bracing, such as getting up from a seated position or for balance while standing. Dog should always be standing square to brace in these situations.
- The MSH Support Handle is designed with low center of gravity to distribute pressure around the dog's core. Support bars mounted to the harness saddle are permanent and will not loosen over time, and feature support D-rings on each side (new 2020 feature at no charge).
- **Support Handle folds down** to allow dogs into tight spaces, in vehicles, under tables or chairs.
- Padded handle grip is comfortable and easy to clean.
- Reflective tape on sides of handlebar for night-time visibility.
- Additional leather handle options are available to add additional functionality to the harness.
- The MSH is <u>only for dogs over 60 pounds</u> that are large and strong enough to perform this physically demanding work for their partner.

NOTE: Rigid support handles must not be leaned on for constant support, pulled on, or used for momentum while walking. Heavy pressure should never be applied to the metal handle, especially while the dog is in motion. The MSH is not recommended for people with ataxia, Parkinson's disease, or similar conditions that cause shaking or tremors because excess movement through the metal handle will throw the dog off balance, add additional strain to the dog, and will feel unstable to the person: the BAH is better suited for such applications. This harness will not fit dogs smaller than the stated minimum weight and measurement size.

Harness Sizes: Standard MSH

For most dogs 60-95 pounds, with a girth size of 28-34 inches (best choice for most retrievers and doodles). NOT available for dogs under 60 pounds.

Extra Large MSH

For most dogs 90-150 pounds, with a girth size of 33-40 inches (also recommended for deep-chested breeds such as GSD's and Dobermans weighing 85 pounds or more, and any dog over 100 pounds such as Rottweilers, smaller Great Danes, Newfoundlands, etc.) Available in black only.

Giant size MSH

For dogs 140-200 pounds, with a girth over 40 inches (best choice for larger Great Danes, St. Bernards, Mastiffs, etc).

Sorry, not all options are available for Giant size. ONLY available in black with standard bars. No tall handles or pull-rings are available.


Harness Leather Color Options:

Black:

Latigo leather is our standard offering. Because the leather is solid black all the way through it does not fade, hides the appearance of scuffs, and wears beautifully over time.

London Tan:

Gorgeous bridle leather. Tan shades may vary slightly; each part of harness may be a different shade but always coordinate beautifully. May darken and show some scuffs with use over time.



Measurements will determine the handle size you need. Handlebars can be replaced at any time with a similar height or shorter. (Tall handles will ONLY fit on harnesses ordered with a TALL handlebar option).

NOTE: Height is the distance between the top of the harness saddle and the top of the handlebar. (The dog's withers are level with the harness top.) Support Handle adjustment range listed is approximate; exact dimensions depend on the harness size and dog's width.







Rigid Support Handles are available in a variety of heights.

Left: 2-4" handle Center: 3-6" handle Right: 9-11" TALL handle

^{*}Tall handles apply more torque and pressure to the dog than shorter handles. Not recommended for most users or any dog smaller than stated minimum size. Consider the BAH if tall handle is required.

Support Handle grip style:

Straight Grip

Standard handle grip is ambidextrous. Your hand and elbow will be positioned directly over the dog's body, with your palm facing back.

Ergonomic Grip *Highly recommended!*

Choose left or right hand. Z-shaped handle grip allows for more natural hand and arm position.

Arm and elbow are able to relax in toward your body while your hand remains centered over the dog. Ergonomic grip is comfortable and balanced for most people, especially those with hand/wrist/ shoulder mobility or pain issues. (When necessary, ergonomic handle can be used with opposite hand; palm will face forward.)



Handle Folding:

ALL support handles fold down!

Handle folding mechanism is engaged by pulling two small pegs—one on each side of the handlebar.

Standard release pegs

Standard release pegs are a small metal knob (dime sized) that pulls out to release the handle so it can fold back. Can be operated together or independently when the built-in locking mechanism is engaged.


Pull-Rings

Highly recommended for weak hands or for one-hand operation.

For people with limited dexterity who have trouble grasping a small peg, Pull-Rings can be added to make it easier to operate the handle folding mechanism. Includes Infini-Key extenders for convenience.

NOTE: all harnesses made after April 1, 2020 can be retrofitted with pull-rings for an additional cost. This retrofit can be done without sending the harness to us, but requires high-dexterity to install.





How to measure for your BAH or MSH harness:

We require specific measurements to make your harness, along with your dog's weight, breed and age. Your harness maker will use this information to make your harness customized for your dog. The included diagrams, photos, and written descriptions will help you gather accurate information.

A helpful measuring video may be found on our website at bld.pet/measuring.

Provide all measurements at the time of your order—you can call us, order online, or email us directly. Please note that delays in receiving complete & accurate order information will affect the turnaround time of your harness order, as we cannot start on the harness without these important details.

The harness specialists at BLD will review all of the details and will contact you if we have questions about your order or measurements. We may make recommendations based on the information you provide. Please accept our experience and suggestions for the most functional equipment options.

Don't panic, we're here to help! Really, don't worry—the straps are adjustable and we'll be sure you get a perfect fit.


Tips & Hints


- Measure the dog according to the diagrams, photos and directions provided.
- There's a worksheet on the back page to keep track of the measurements and any questions remaining after reading this packet.
- The dog and user do NOT have to be together to measure for these harnesses.
- Measure the <u>harness user</u> to determine the correct handle height. It's very important the handle (s) fit the person; please don't guess the handle height.
- Take each measurement 2 or 3 times for accuracy. Each time may give you different results; this is normal, don't panic. Try again and average the numbers.
- **Measuring tools:** A cloth/tailor's measuring tape is ideal because it is flexible. If you don't have one, use a string for measuring around your dog's body and then measure the string against a measuring tape or yard stick. Use a flat ruler for the width.
- If your dog is nervous with a measuring tape, try using a leash around their body, then measure the leash separately.
- You may want a friend to help you.
 - No helper? Smear something tasty on a paper plate and tape it to the wall at the dog's eye level to keep him occupied while you measure him.
- For the dog's height and person's wrist/hand measurements, you can tape a piece of paper to the wall to mark the height. Then measure from that mark to the ground.



BAH & MSH Measuring: anatomy diagrams



Instructions to Measure the Dog:

- **First, get out the very best treats** you have, perhaps cheese, ham, or peanut butter! This is a great opportunity to have a helper bait your dog with a fistful of soft treats to keep your dog focused on trying to lick the food.
- Have the dog <u>stand</u> square and balanced when taking <u>all</u> measurements. (No sitting or lying down.) Keep the measuring tape snug.
- Start by finding your dog's withers, marked in yellow on the photos. The withers are the top of the shoulder blades (indicated with a grey oval). The bones can be felt over the dog's legs and shoulders, just below the dog's neck.
- Next, locate what we at BLD call the "sweet spot," this is where the dog's back begins. It is immediately behind the withers. Feel the withers, and palpate (use your fingers to probe) as you move down the dog's back (just an inch or two) to feel for a bit of a dip in the dog's spine. It is important that the girth and belly measurement are taken at this spot because this is where the harness saddle will sit on your dog.
- In the photo below, the "sweet spot" is where the girth and belly guides meet just behind the withers.





1) Measure Height from withers to the floor

- This measurement should be a **straight, vertical line from the top of the shoulders to the ground.** If using a flexible measuring tape, **do not bend** the tape over the dog.
- Place a book or other flat object across the shoulders if you need. We use a blue ruler in the photos.
 Additionally, you can ask your dog to stand next to a wall and mark his height on the paper taped to the wall (as shown in the photo on p. 27).

2) Measure the Girth

- This measurement goes around your dog's ribs, behind the front legs, at the deepest part of his chest. Start the measuring at the "sweet spot" behind the withers, go down under the deepest part of the dog's chest and back around to the top.
- The measuring tape should be mostly vertical, forming a complete circle around the dog's chest.
 Measure snugly but don't squish your dog. (With long haired dogs, be sure you're measuring the dog's body, not just their floof!)

3) Measure the **Belly** (see photo on previous page)

- Similar to the girth, the belly is measured all the way around the dog's ribs/chest, but the bottom of tape measure will be further back under the dog's ribs, at a diagonal angle.
- o First, locate the spot under your dog's belly where his/her ribs come together and join the sternum (indicated in red on the diagram on p. 28, and the photo on p. 29). Feel the dog's side and find the back of his ribcage, then count 3-4 ribs forward. Follow this rib down and palpate to find the notch where the deep part of his chest curves up toward the belly (flanks).
- Bring the measuring tape under this point of the dog's ribs, and pull the tape up and forward to the "sweet spot." The measuring tape must be snug. The measure will be at a diagonal angle.
- Pro Tip: put the measuring tape under your dog and "see-saw" it back and forth while pulling forward toward the withers—this settles the tape nicely under the belly, and then bring both sides of the tape to the "sweet spot."
- O Avoid measuring vertically around the dog's waist, or place the measuring tape so far back it reaches the dog's flanks—both will yield inaccurate measurements. Usually, the belly and girth measurement are within 3 inches of each other. Remember, we will let you know if anything doesn't look right!
- Some boxy and/or long bodied dogs may not have a clearly defined tuck, just try your best!

4) Measure the dog's Width

- There are two ways to measure the dog's width. Both are best with a regular flat ruler.
- This is an important measurement; the handle(s) will be made based on how wide your dog is, so take this measurement multiple times for accuracy
- o **Bird's Eye View method:** This method works well with dogs that have heavy muscling in the shoulders and short coats. Stand directly above your dog looking straight down over his body. If you touch one hand to each side of his ribs, how far apart are your hands?
- Doorway method: Lure your dog through a partially open door. Have your dog squeeze through the doorway and stop when his shoulders are just past the doorjamb; measure the width of the door opening at the dog's ribcage. Be sure the door and doorjamb touch the dog. This works well with a sliding door, and a fistful of tasty treats. (The measuring video has a good demonstration of this method.)



Pro Tip: Have dog stand in a doorway, with door and door jam touching his sides. Measure the opening.




Instructions to Measure for the Handle:

Now it's time to measure the person who will use the harness to determine the handle size. Measure the hand that will primarily be used on the harness (most dogs work on the person's left side, with left hand on the handle). Please take each measurement 2-3 times for accuracy.

Use the harness worksheet on the following page to calculate your handle height.

This is best done with a helper who can assure you're standing naturally and measure for you so you don't have to bend over.

No Helper? No problem! Tape a piece of paper to a wall. Stand with your shoulder touching the wall. Use a pencil to mark the paper at your **hand** and **wrist** heights as described below. Then, measure the wall from the ground to the marks.



Ideally, the top of a rigid handle aligns with your wrist joint when your arm is relaxed at your side—this is similar to how a cane or walking stick is measured.

- 1) Stand while wearing normal shoes.
- 2) Be sure you are balanced and comfortable. Are you standing up straight? No slouching! Relax your shoulders. Steady yourself with a cane if you need.
- **3)** Allow arm to hang naturally at your side. (Don't bend or straighten your arm, just be relaxed.)
- **4) Measure from the bend in the wrist to the floor.** Shoe check! Be sure to wear everyday shoes.
- **5)** Repeat! Move around, shake out your arm. Stand up straight, relax the shoulders, and measure again.

B: Hand to ground: for all leather handle options

Follow steps above for 1 & 2

- 3) Hold a pencil in your hand (or similar object to represent a handle) clutching it the way you wish to hold the harness handle.
- **4) Allow your arm to relax.** Let your elbow relax naturally as you hold the pencil comfortably. (Don't bend or straighten your arm.)
- 5) Measure from the pencil to the floor.
- 6) Repeat!

By default, we will use the wrist and/or hand measurements to calculate the handle heights. If hand/wrist are at or lower than the dog's back, we suggest the minimum heights: a 2-4" rigid, or 3" leather handle.

You are welcome to specify specific handle heights! Please tell us if you'd like something else. For example, if you will only use the rigid metal handle for bracing to rise from a chair or transfer to a chair (not when you're standing/ walking), then we suggest a short 2-4" handle for the greatest stability. If you want a secondary handle nice and short for pulling yourself up, or on stairs, just tell us. For Support Pull handles, we suggest 1-2" lower than the rigid metal support handle (so the leather handle tucks under the metal grip.)
