 for harnesses; make and assemble product such as dog collars and leashes; accurately and
 consistently produce product/parts to established standards for function, quality, and
 performance; follow verbal and written specifications for product assembly; make customized
 product to customer specifications; sew heavy materials on industrial sewing machines; do light
 industrial metalwork (stainless steel and aluminum)
- **Organization:** Maintain work areas in a neat and orderly fashion, especially packing & shipping materials for efficient workflow; sort and organize other workshop parts and supplies as requested
- Supply Inventory: stock and maintain inventory for packing & shipping supplies including: wrapping

- Packing & Shipping: Handle packing and shipping for outgoing orders; verify products match the order, pack individual products and completed orders to established standards, identify the most

efficient and cost-effective shipping container and method, print shipping labels using various methods including QuickBooks interface and shipping provider's websites; complete each day's outgoing orders in a timely fashion for daily mail carrier pickup

- Support Daily Operations: provide support for workshop and other administrative tasks as needed, including filing or scanning documents, light cleaning, preparing information packets, inventory counts, etc.
